VISA ON ARRIVAL IN INDIA

The government has decided to issue visas on arrival to citizens from five countries at Chennai, Mumbai, Delhi and Kolkata airports starting Friday, i.e. 1st January 2010. Those holding passports of Japan, New Zealand, Singapore, Luxembourg and Finland would be eligible to fly in without a visa.

Tourists will be charged \$60 at the airport counters for the visa.

The system will be beneficial primarily to visitors in two categories: those who club one or two countries together in their itinerary and those who intend to make short visits to India to visit friends or relatives.

Incidentally, India has already introduced long-term multiple entry visas for 18 countries including France, Germany, Spain, Switzerland, Brazil, Chile, Vietnam, and Japan.
